## Coalition Strategy:

The coalition focuses on education and awareness, which increases identification, support to survivors, and a clear understanding of the issue. Coalition impact is measured via the Delaware General Health District's Community Health Assessments. Goals for the coalition include:

- 20% of Delaware County residents will be aware of the issue of human trafficking.
- 5% of people who live, work, and/or worship in Delaware County will show an increase in knowledge of the issue of human trafficking.
